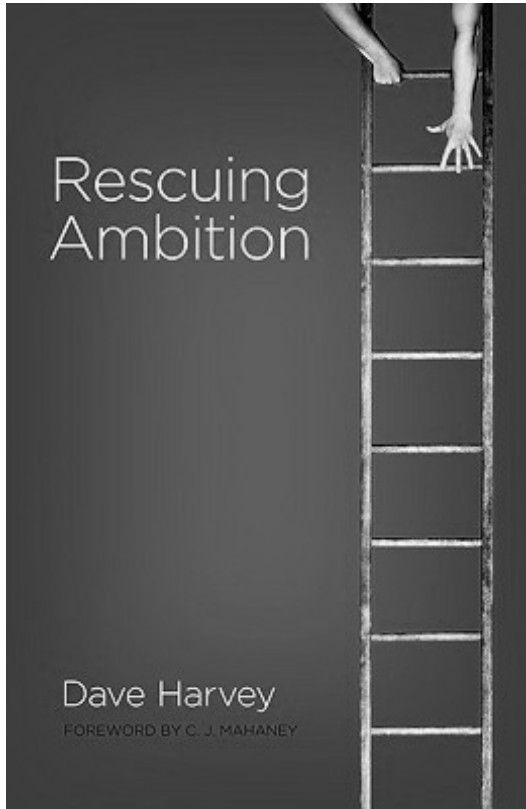


Discipleship Class: Rescuing Ambition
